

**TOWN OF VASS  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
PUBLIC HEARING  
February 27, 2012**

The public hearing was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Callahan. Commissioners in attendance were: Blackwell, Bridgers, Callahan, and Cirone. Commissioner Kellis was absent.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear comments on the intent of the town to apply for a \$750,000 Community Development Block Grant to extend sewer lines in the area of US # 1 North, Poplar St., Barnes Ave., Vine Street and Lincoln Ave.

Paulette Elliott of 120 Lincoln Ave. said she and her husband were in favor of the proposal and that she currently does not have sewer at her home. She questioned if we could apply for more than \$750,000 and was told that \$750,000 was the maximum amount for this grant. She also asked if the town received the grant and the bids came in under the \$750,000 amount could sewer be extended to more people on Union-Church Road. She was told that was a possibility.

There being no further questions, Commissioner Cirone made a motion to close the public hearing at 7:15 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
